Concerns: proceedings for Delivery of the in-situ monitoring system to control epitaxial growth - nr F2/59/2022/ZP

The Contracting Entity on base of art. 284 paragraph 6 of the Act Public Procurement Law of 11 September 2019 (Official Journal of 2019, item 2019, with later changes) I'm sending answers and explanations due to the Terms of Reference.

1st Question

We have received the documents and are currently checking all details. One big challenge will be the delivery time. In the tender it says „the contract shall be performed at the latest up to 12 weeks from the date of signing the agreement“. Could you please specify how long it will take until the bidder will receive the information about the agreement (after the tender has been closed)? Also could you please let us know if you „only“ mean the date of shipment of the „in-situ monitoring tool“ or also installation and training of the measurement tool. This is not completely in our hands as the Epiluvac reactor needs to fulfill some criteria in order for us to be able to install and successfully measure on the reactor. I can tell you at present that our production is already working on full capacity within the next weeks (or even months) so we need to check with our production team how we can fit it in the production plan if we successfully participate in the tender.

Answer:

The Contract should be fulfilled up to **12 weeks** from the date of signing the agreement. It means that it should be fulfilled: delivery, installation, putting into operation and testing of a brand new of the in-situ monitoring system to control epitaxial growth with guarantee and support services, documentation and trainings.

Time between end of the tender and final agreement cannot be determine at this time.
